Matthew 5: 16 (New International Version)

<sup>16</sup>In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.

Luke 12: 29, 31 (New International Version)

<sup>29</sup>And do not set your heart on what you will eat or drink; do not worry about it... <sup>31</sup>But seek his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well.

Luke 6: 27, 28, 31 (New International Version)

<sup>27</sup>"But I tell you who hear me: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, <sup>28</sup>bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you...<sup>31</sup>Do to others as you would have them do to you.

Matthew 12: 30 (New International Version)

<sup>30</sup>"He who is not with me is against me, and he who does not gather with me scatters.

Matthew 13: 16 (New International Version)

<sup>16</sup> But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear.

Mark 4: 39-41 (New International Version)

<sup>39</sup>He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm.

<sup>40</sup>He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?"

<sup>41</sup>They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"

Matthew 15: 17-18 (New International Version)

Mark 8: 34 (New International Version)

<sup>34</sup>Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.

Mark 1: 10-11 (New International Version)

<sup>10</sup>As Jesus was coming up out of the water, he saw heaven being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. <sup>11</sup>And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased."

Matthew 18: 4 (New International Version)

John 7: 38 (New International Version)

Mark 10: 27 (New International Version)

<sup>27</sup>Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God."

Matthew 20: 18-19 (New International Version)

Matthew 25: 40 (New International Version)
