

Thinking Questions

Use these questions to build the visual tool.

- Who is in this story?
- What does the character look like?
- What does the character do?
- What does the character say?
- What thoughts/ feelings does the character have?

Use this question to determine connections on the visual tool.

- How do the character's thoughts/ feelings and actions connect?

These questions help determine perspective.

- What significant events exist in the text?
- How does the character view this event/ other character/ idea/ issue?

Documentation with page numbers is very important.

- What section of the text supports this?

These are summary questions.

- Do other areas of the character's thoughts/ feelings, dialogue, appearance, and/or actions connect to communicate a certain trait?
- Does this trait affect the character's actions and /or relationship with other characters?
- Do characters have differing perspectives of the same event?

Pattern Statement

Character can develop through interactions with others and through events.
